Realities of Restoration

- Denial and is Undeniable (John 18:15-18, 25-27)
- Though restoration is a journey, it hinges upon a single question.
- Though true restoration in Christ is always free, it will cost you your life.

They went back to the familiar and even that failed.

The Journey or Process Matters

1. Regret/Remorse: "I'm disappointed in myself and convicted of my sin."
2. Recognize: "I didn't just make a mistake, I denied Him with my actions."
3. Return: "I'm coming back to you Lord because I know peace will not be found elsewhere."
4. Request: "I need and ask for your grace and forgiveness."
5. Repent: "I'm turning away from my sin and creating any safeguards and accountability needed."
6. Receive: "I trust Christ over my feelings and His promise to forgive me."
7. Renew: "I'm renewing my commitment to walk with The Lord."
8. Remember: "I will not forget my frailty, His forgiveness, and my focus."
