Legal Definition: Complaint The pleading that starts a case. Essentially, a document that sets forth a jurisdictional basis for the court's power, the plaintiffs cause of action, and a demand for judicial relief.

Legal Definition: Closing Argument The final address to the jury by the attorney for each side of a case in which the attorney usually summarized the evidence and his or her client's position.

Matthew 5:39-42; 1 Peter 2:23



The questions you should ask when a grievance comes:

- 1. Have I searched my heart and my motives to determine whether the wrong done to me is significant enough to pursue action (personally or legally?)
- 2. Is the person who has wronged me also a follower of Christ?
- 3. Have I sought to resolve the matter privately, graciously, and honestly?
- 4. If my individual efforts have failed, have I sought leadership in the church to help me in this matter?
- 5. Have I considered not pursuing justice in this matter even though it may result in my personal loss?
- 6. If, after much prayer, deliberation, and effort, I feel it necessary to take legal action, have I explained to my legal representation that my only desire is a fair settlement for all parties involved? (Vindictiveness, revenge, or an effort to hurt have no place in our lives)
